William Cobbett Society

Contemporaries of William Cobbett, who was born in Farnham and is buried in St Andrew's churchyard, would have known of him as a radical politician and the foremost political journalist of the age.

The William Cobbett Society was founded in 1976 to bring together those who have an interest in the life and writings of William Cobbett. A passionate defender of the freedom of the press Cobbett was prepared to defend it at the cost of imprisonment and exile.

'He is not only unquestionably the most powerful political writer of the present day, but one of the best writers in the language. He speaks and thinks plain, broad, downright English'. The only time I ever saw him he seemed to me a very pleasant man: easy of access, affable, clear-headed, deliberate and unruffled in his speech... I certainly did not think less favourably of him for seeing him'.

Farnham Building Preservation Trust Limited

The Farnham Trust is a registered charitable trust and a limited company, founded in 1968 with the objective of preserving heritage assets in and around Farnham. It has a long and distinguished record of saving threatened historic buildings, restoring them and returning them to viable future use.

Major projects have included a contribution to the saving of the Farnham Maltings in 1969, work on the New Ashgate Gallery in the 1980s, and the rescue of the Farnham Pottery from imminent demolition in 1998.

The Trust has around 50 ordinary members, including 12 who are elected trustees and meet monthly as the Executive Board, working on a voluntary basis.

Membership of the Trust is free, and those who support its aims are welcome to apply to the Secretary.

The Annual General Meeting is held in June or July.

Potters Gate Children's Centre

Potters Gate Children's Centre is located in the centre of Farnham and provides a wide range of activities, children's health clinics, and play and learn sessions, for families with children aged 0-5.

Some of groups are drop in, advance booking or invitation only. The majority of sessions are for families who live in the reach area, defined by Surrey Early Years, which includes Farnham town centre to The Chantrys, out to Roman Way, Weybank, Stoke Hills, part of Wrecclesham, the Ridgeway area and the Runfold border. Their entrance is off Beavers Road and the office is open Monday-Thursday 9am-1pm plus session times. Two Counties Care Ltd

Two Counties Care Limited was established in Farnham in 2007 and provides support for older people to help them live safely and as independently as possible in their own homes. Regulated by the Care Quality Commission, the

Company has qualified staff trained in specialist areas such as dementia care. Two Counties Care Ltd also run Farnham's Alzheimer Cafe at the Weydon Christian Centre in Upper Way, Farnham. This is offered free of charge to those people in our community who are directly affected by Dementia, including their families and carers. It is organised by Two Counties Care but is run by volunteers and is a not for profit concern.

Who is it for?

The café is for all persons with concerns about memory problems and any form of dementia, together with their spouses, children, grandchildren, family, friends and care givers. It is also for professionals involved in this specialist area of care.

The purpose

To enjoy being out together and to meet people who are all in the same boat. Here families and professionals can share and discuss problems in a relaxed and safe environment.

What is provided?

The Café is organised and run by Two Counties Care Limited, in association with the Weydon Christian Centre. Visitors will find a welcoming Café atmosphere with good food and music, usually live. Most sessions will include a short 'presentation' and discussion about some aspect of living with dementia. There are opportunities to share feelings and give and receive support and information.

When?

The fourth Wednesday of the month from 6:30-9:00 pm. (There is no meeting in June.)

Where?

Parking:

The centre has its own car park and parking is free of charge. There are also spaces on the roadside should the car park be full.

Woodlarks campsite – camping for the disabled

Throughout the summer this beautiful Surrey camp site offers week long holidays to hundreds of disabled people, cared for by dedicated volunteer helpers.

Woodlarks is a charity dedicated to providing a permanent camp site for people with disabilities of all ages. Seven of the week-long camps are open to all comers though vary with age groups. Most other weeks during the camping season from April to September are booked by special needs schools and groups.

Outdoors there's a heated swimming pool nestling in a sheltered valley. A zip wire (aerial runway) with special seat runs through the tree tops. There's a trampoline and other sports equipment, a bird hide and BBQ sites in the woods and lots of space. Alongside the brick built dining room is Bradbury Croft, which provides up-to-date welfare facilities including ceiling hoists, wet rooms, toilets and two sleeping rooms with electronically adjustable beds.

Mellow Farm Campsite

Mellow Farm is a small, family farm of 110 hectares on the beautiful Hampshire-Surrey border and is centred on the River Wey. It is set on sandy heathland and is either grassland or small wooded areas.

The farm itself produces turf and hay and has a few cattle, but also is home to several small traditional businesses, including a blacksmith in a forge that has been there since at least 1566!

The farm offers several activities on site, such as an assault course, canoeing, abseiling and archery. There is extensive walking on the heathland that stretches from Frensham Common through Elstead to Hindhead.

Opening times:

Farnham Institute Charity

The Farnham Institute Charity was founded in 1890 by George Trimmer. The charity exists to benefit the people of Farnham and the environs. The nine Trustees meet four or five times each year and consider applications for equipment to help local groups and organisations. The young and old, the arts and music, sport and hospitals are among the many groups who have benefited from grants made by the Farnham Institute which distributes about £55,000 per annum. Applications from clubs and organisations are welcome. Please note applications from individuals seeking funding are not considered. Grants do not exceed £5,000.

The Hedgehogs

The Hedgehogs are Farnham's local charity formed in 1959 and now a Registered Charity 'Helping Local People in Need'. They have a membership of over 50 and are acknowledged as a major support group in the Farnham area.

Their funds are raised by attending local shows, fetes, fayres, marquee and associated equipment hire. They are joint partners in the organising and running of Farnham Town Carnival, they hold an annual golf day, Beerex , plus numerous other one-off special charity events throughout the year to raise funds.

Over the past 10 years they have raised over a third of a million pounds which has been donated to local individuals in need, organisations and charities within the Farnham locality. The Hedgehogs' running costs are paid for by members and friends so that all funds raised are used solely for good causes.

Performers Together (a Community Interest Company)

Performers Together Community Interest Company was formed as the result of over 80 local arts and educational organisations recognising the need for a new performing arts venue in Farnham. It is a Community Interest Company, a new form of business structure with charitable aims, run by volunteers and ideally suited to such a venture.

The company's aim: To work towards the establishment and consequent management and development of a purpose built and dedicated performing arts centre which will meet the expressed needs of the local community and its various performing

arts groups, professional and amateur, which cannot currently be met. By corralling the strengths of all their member groups and individuals together, they speak with a stronger voice. Their group members, their talents, energy and expertise contribute to further the company's aim. They welcome new members. Performers Together is very proud of its two patrons, each of them a significant force in their own area of expertise: Simon Russell Beale, acclaimed actor, musician and presenter; and David Whelton OBE, a Farnham resident and the Managing Director of the Philharmonia Orchestra, resident at the Royal Festival Hall

Farnham Bridge Club

This Club offers the opportunity for members to play duplicate bridge and teams of four in a friendly but competitive environment. New members are welcomed and are helped to find partners if required. The hands are machine dealt and printouts are available at the end of the evening's play.

The Club plays in the [Memorial Hall](#), West Street, Farnham from 7.30 – 10.30 pm on most Wednesday and Friday evenings. Players should arrive by 7.15.

Farnham Country Market

Farnham Country Market, formerly the WI Market, is a co-operative which endeavors to keep alive arts, crafts, and baking and encourage future generations to enjoy the pride of 'home produced'.

The range of goods for sale include a whole range of cakes, bakes and savouries, honey, turned wood, greetings cards, knitted and sewn items, homemade soap, jewellery, gifts, and preserves.

High standards for all producers are required so customers can be assured of good quality products. The market is governed by strict regulations, and cooks have regular visits by the Environmental Health officer to inspect their kitchens.

The market was established in 1949 and meets in the United Reformed Church Hall (opposite Sainsbury's) every Friday morning from 9.30 – 11am, and at the Maltings market on the first Saturday of the month.

Creative Response (Arts) Ltd

Creative Response is an independent fine arts based innovative, independent organisation that works with and for vulnerable people mostly from Farnham and it's environs, in order that they may experience, enjoy and explore their own creativity. The creative spirit runs through the organisation and it is their responsibility to share it, in order that it grows, develops and heals.

There are two purpose built dance studios to hire at the Showshack Studios, Farnham.

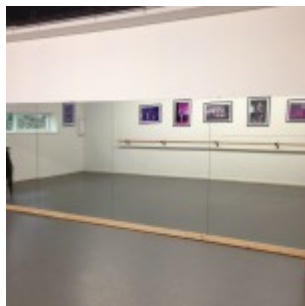
The first is the main hall which measures 14.5 metres by 9.5 metres. As well as a dance venue the hall can also be hired for children's parties.

Farnham & District Model Railway Club

Farnham and District Model Railway Club (F&DMRC) meets every Wednesday from 3 – 10pm.

They have active groups in 0, 00, P4 and N gauges, with their Weydon Road 0 gauge, Greenfield Sidings 00 gauge, Brixcombe P4, and Basingstoke N gauge layouts already on the exhibition circuit. New smaller N and 0 gauge layouts are currently being worked on. Club members also have interests in other scales and prototypes including gauge 1, 009, 16mm, trams, and 2mm finescale.

The club has test tracks for 0, 00, P4 and N gauges which are set up twice a month. They have at least two open days each year, and their big event is their exhibition every October. They also run a programme of demonstrations, presentations and events throughout the year.

Old Farnhamians' Association (OFA)

During the period 1585 to 1973, Farnham Grammar School educated several thousand boys from the town of Farnham and the surrounding villages; in the later years, many boys from other towns such as Guildford, Woking and Godalming also attended this school.
