All exhibits must be washed and prepared before entry into the class. In all classes, exhibitors are requested to name the cultivars used in their entries where known.

All exhibits must remain on the show benches until the Presentation of Awards is complete.

#### **Awards**

A Cup will be awarded to the Winner of Class I.

A Cup will be awarded for most points in all Classes.

A Cup will be awarded for the Best Exhibit in all Classes excluding Class 1.

The Neville Watkins Cup will be awarded for the Best Specimen Dahlia in Class 34.
