- On average we supply around 530 million litres of water every day to meet demand
- During hot dry periods, demand increases rapidly to over 650 million litres a day


Key Project facts

- A new pipe is required to maintain drinking water supply to the area as the community grows
- The pipe will be installed in West Street, private land close to Coxbridge Farm, Runwick Lane and the A31 Alton Road
- The project is a £1.1 million investment into improving the water network in the Farnham area
- We currently estimate the entire project will take approximately six months to complete
- The project will start on 9 January 2022.



Phase one – West Street

- Work will begin in West Street on 9 January 2023
- There will be 2 way lights on West Street to start with to set up our off road storage area.
- A road closure will be required in West Street to keep the community safe from the 20 January
- The road will be restored to its original state once all works are completed.
- Businesses will remain open as normal
- · Access to homes will always be maintained
- Deliveries and refuse collections will continue as normal
- Although access will remain, the direction of entry may alter as our works progress.




Phase two – private land

- The second phase will take place entirely within private land and therefore there will be no disruption to the public
- We consider ourselves to be guardians of the environment and all of our construction work considers the protection and conservation of the local environment.




Phase three – A31 Alton Road and Runwick Lane

- Once work in phase two completes, we will begin installing pipe in Runwick Lane and A31 Alton Road
- Runwick Lane will be closed for approximately three weeks
- A series of lane closures will be in place to protect motorists from our working area along A31 Alton Road
- Some vegetation clearance will be required when we install the pipe within rural areas.
- This route avoids prolonged works on the A31
