| 2 | Brightwells Yard<br>(https://www.brightwells-<br>farnham.com/)                             | Brightwells Yard is a large-scale regeneration scheme in<br>the centre of Farnham which opened in 2024. The<br>development offers a hub for leisure and evening<br>entertainment, with a new six-screen cinema, a variety<br>of restaurants and retail units and 239 new homes. The<br>design is centred around a community square. The<br>scheme is being actively integrated into the town centre<br>as part of the strategic development plan, following a<br>slower-than expected uptake of retail units. |
| 3 | Riverside Walk between<br>Brightwells and along<br>Borelli path to Riverside 3<br>car park | This is a newly regenerated scheme, which is part of the<br>FIP scheme (see 'Locations'). Riverside Walk between<br>Brightwells and the Riverside car parks has been<br>reopened after being upgraded to a shared walking and<br>cycling path.  |
