Options for Expanded Coverage Areas include:

	Location	Details
1	Gostrey Meadow	A key town centre location: There has historically been coverage in this area (see above). There is widespread support to increase and enhance this coverage and to give to give greater impact.
2	Brightwells Yard (https://www.brightwells-farnham.com/)	Brightwells Yard is a large-scale regeneration scheme in the centre of Farnham which opened in 2024. The development offers a hub for leisure and evening entertainment, with a new six-screen cinema, a variety of restaurants and retail units and 239 new homes. The design is centred around a community square. The scheme is being actively integrated into the town centre as part of the strategic development plan, following a slower-than expected uptake of retail units.
3	Riverside Walk between Brightwells and along Borelli path to Riverside 3 car park	This is a newly regenerated scheme, which is part of the FIP scheme (see 'Locations'). Riverside Walk between Brightwells and the Riverside car parks has been reopened after being upgraded to a shared walking and cycling path.
4	Entrance roads to the town (eg Coxbridge, Shepherd & Flock and Six Bells)	To provide a welcoming arrival for visitors and residents.
