

# Your council tax at work

In 2026/27, £91.67 (3.5%) of the total council tax paid by Farnham households that live in a Band D property is allocated to Farnham Town Council. This is equivalent to £1.76 per week and will help pay for services that keep Farnham, community focussed, safe, vibrant, welcoming and thriving. This is how the money will be spent per household (Band D property).

# Where your council tax goes

✓ The council tax you pay is shared out between Surrey County Council, Waverley Borough Council, the Police & Crime Commissioner and Waverley's town and parish councils. This is where Farnham people's council tax will go in 2026/27:

**74.5%** Surrey County Council

**8.5%** Waverley Borough Council

**13.5%** Police & Crime Commissioner

**3.5%** Farnham Town Council
